## Avid NEXIS: Getting Started and Connecting

This guide will cover workflow and basic troubleshooting for connecting to and using the Avid NEXIS shared storage unit.

### Important Notes when Using the NEXIS

Before using the NEXIS shared storage unit, it's important to note the following:

- Connecting to the NEXIS is a 2-step process that involves first connecting to the overall system and then mounting a specific workspace.
- The NEXIS is siloed, meaning it can only be accessed from computers with a direct connection:
  - 1176 (10Gb connection)
    - Preferred, especially for ingesting, transcoding, or any other work that involves writing large amount of data to the NEXIS
  - 1081 & 1082 (1Gb connection)
    - OK for editing work that doesn't involve creating new media
    - Discouraged for ingesting, transcoding, or any other work that involves writing large amount of data to the NEXIS
