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Fund of Documentary I - Premiere Tech Part I

Tech 1: 180 Min

In this technical seminar, you will learn the basics of Adobe Premiere editing. After an introduction from the post production area tech instructor, students may work at their own pace, and are encouraged to ask questions as they move through the material.  - ★ If you miss this step, your media will go offline the next time you edit. Always make sure that you are working from the media on your drive, not the computer's hard drive.
