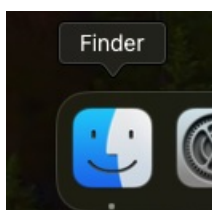

This guide describes how to mount the TrueNAS server from multiple sources.

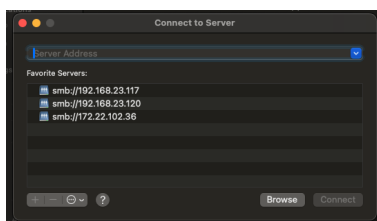
Mounting the TrueNAS from the TV Studios

To mount the TrueNAS from a computer on the Industry City network:

1. Launch *Finder*.



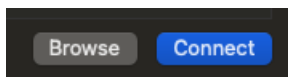
2. Press *Cmd + K*.



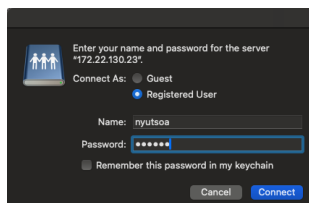
3. In the *Connect to Server* pop-up window, enter the following:
 - a. smb://172.22.130.23

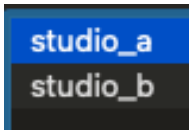
4. Click *Connect*.



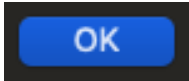
5. When prompted, enter the credentials.
 - a. nyutsoa/b0bcac



6. In the pop-up window, select a studio you wish to connect to.



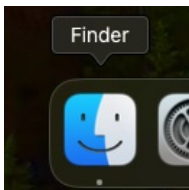
7. Click Ok.



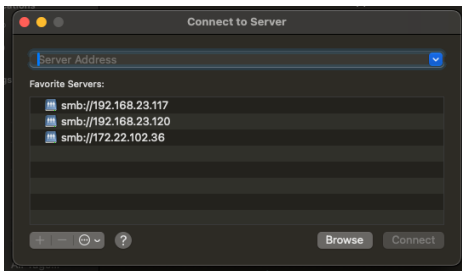
Mounting the TrueNAS from an outside computer (MacOS).

To mount the TrueNAS on a computer **not** on the Industry City network:

1. Connect to the [NYU VPN](#).
2. Launch *Finder*.



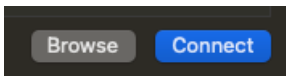
3. Press *Cmd + K*.



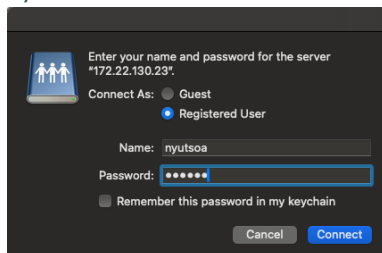
4. In the *Connect to Server* pop-up window, enter the following:
 - a. `smb://172.22.130.23`



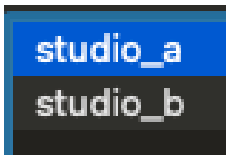
5. Click *Connect*.



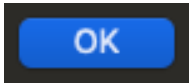
6. Click *Continue*.
7. When prompted, enter the credentials.
 - a. `nyutsoa/b0bc`



8. In the pop-up window, select a studio you wish to connect to.



9. Click Ok.

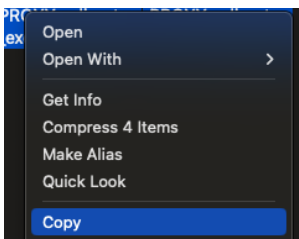


To save your files from the TrueNAS to your local storage:

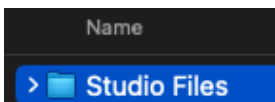
1. Select your files.



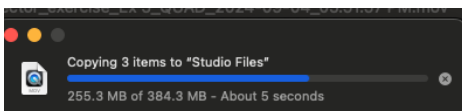
2. Press `Cmd + C`.



3. Navigate in Finder to your local storage.



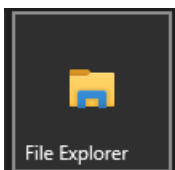
4. In the local storage folder you'd like to save the files to, press `Cmd + V`.



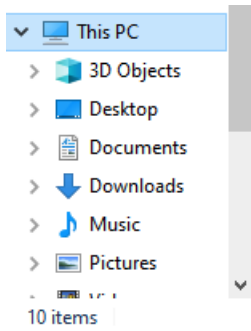
Mounting the TrueNAS from an outside computer (Windows OS).

To mount the TrueNAS on a computer **not** on the Industry City network:

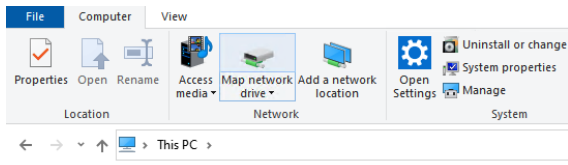
1. Connect to the [NYU VPN](#).
2. Launch *File Explorer*.



3. Select *This PC* from the left side menu.



4. From the top of the page, select *Map Network Drive*.



5. In the pop-up window, enter the following in the *Folder* answer field:

- a. \\172.22.130.23\

6. After the backslash, enter the share name for the studio you would like to access:

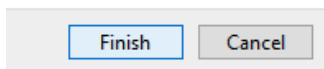
- a. studio_a

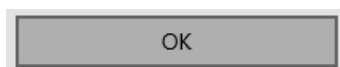

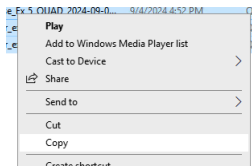

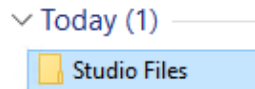

2. Press **Ctrl + C**.
