Casting Calls:

A casting call is a way to get the word out to actors about your film. In the casting call, include these elements:

- Write a brief description of the film with its title. Provide a brief overview of the genre and tone, along with a concise summary of the plot. This should be at most two sentences.
- Remember to stipulate that this is a non-union and non-paying job but that you
 will compensate your actors by providing food, transportation (if the location is
 far from the city), and a copy of the finished film as soon as it is available
 - Note: If you elect to pay your actors, you will be subject to paying union pension and health contributions (for members of SAG-AFTRA) and state/federal employer-paid taxes. For more information, visit the <u>Performers & Subjects</u> section of the Kanbar Film and TV Production website.
