Overview

SAG-AFTRA is a union for actors. They represent their performers with collective bargaining agreements and have strict eligibility requirements, so their members are highly skilled and experienced. To work with union actors, you will need to become a signatory of an agreement and follow all of the union's policies. Becoming a signatory of an agreement provides access to actors in the SAG-AFTRA and Actors' Equity guilds.

Student-friendly agreements outlined below allow the actors' salaries to be deferred (not waived) and provide for limited exhibition.
