If you are taking a Tisch Collaborative Arts or Open Arts course that involves the use of video and/or audio recording, for the purposes of documenting public activity and/or recording actors in staged scenes, you must adhere to the following **NYU Basic Production Safety Guidelines**.

Students who fail to comply with the following requirements will participate in an Academic Review, and are subject to disciplinary consequences within the school, and any appropriate governing bodies regarding federal or state laws.

General Health & Safety Requirements

For On Campus Productions/Exercises

Any actor or crew member who is not a current student or employee is considered a visitor, vendor, or affiliate. NYU alumni are also considered visitors.
