Our goal is to have all UGFTV Advanced film and television productions incorporate sustainable practices outlined in the [Green Production Guide](#) (GPG) and the [Green Film School Alliance](#) (GFSA)

In the GPG and GFSA , you will find many valuable resources to add to the many provided on this Kanbar Resource page. Most importantly, under the GPG "Toolkit" tab you will find the Production Environmental Action Checklist (PEACHy). You can also find PEACHy on the Kanbar Resource page under the Sustainable Production tab. This Guide was created by and is being used throughout the film and television industry in their transition to sustainable production.

We encourage all student productions to review the benchmarks established in the Guide and implement what they can. Those productions who succeed in doing so can submit their PEACHy checklists to the UGFTV Director of Sustainability who will review your submission and, if all is in order, will submit your checklist to the Environmental Media Association (EMA) for review. If EMA approves your submission you will be awarded the EMA Silver Seal confirming your accomplishment. The Silver Seal can be added to your final film and to all marketing for your film. It will prepare you for how industry productions are managed and it will help mitigate the climate emergency we face.
