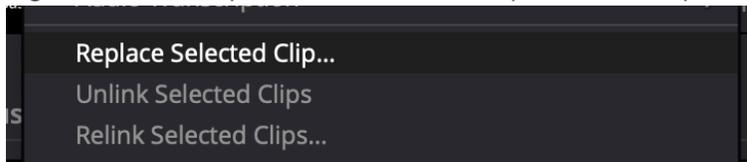
Conforming Media in DaVinci Resolve

Importing a timeline file from another application (such as an XML from Premiere or an AAF from Avid) sometimes causes DaVinci Resolve to populate a timeline with the wrong media. Pointing Resolve to the correct media is a process known as **conforming**.

Conforming Clips in the Bin

To conform clips in the bin to different media files:

1. Right-click on the clip in the bin and choose *Replace selected clip*.



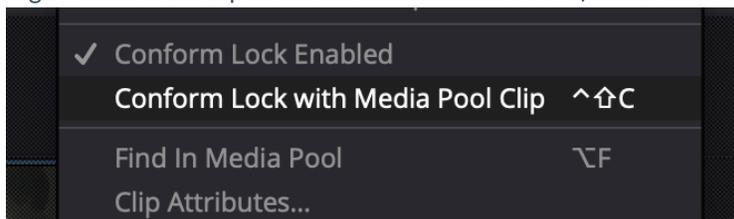
2. Navigate to the correct media file, select it, and click the **Open** button.

The clip should now point to the correct media file.

Conforming Clips in the Timeline

To conform timeline clips to a different clip in the bin:

1. Select the clip in the bin you want to use in the timeline.
2. Right-click on the clip in the timeline and choose *Conform Lock with Media Pool Clip*.



The clip in the timeline will now reference the desired clip in the bin.
