## **Production Advisement**

- Every production class is assigned a production advisor who will assist the instructor with granting production approval and can help answer questions about production guidelines and the production approval workflow.
- In addition to working with their teacher, students should consult with their production advisor early to identify and address any elements of their project that may pose a potential safety concern.
